

REENTRY WORKS!

Reentry Works is a robust, opportunity-rich program that will foster stable employment and reduce recidivism for individuals with current or past involvement in the criminal justice system.

As part of the program participants will:

- Meet with an Intake Coordinator for an initial assessment of their education, training, and work history to determine the level of service needed.
- Be assigned a case manager to develop an individualized employment plan.
- Receive one-on-one lessons including employment-focused cognitive curriculum, job readiness skills, financial literacy, and job search and placement.
- Have access to the Reentry Works computer based learning center for assisted job searches, completion of online applications and computer literacy classes.
- Receive one year of job retention support.
