



SENIOR FARMERS MARKET NUTRITION PROGRAM

Presented by: PA Department of Agriculture & Berks County Area Agency on Aging

June 01, 2017 through November 30, 2017

Checks are available on a first come first served basis and will not be distributed after 9/30/17

Use checks to purchase only the fruits, vegetables and herbs grown in Pennsylvania or neighboring states. Items not covered by the checks include jams, honey, nuts, cider, baked goods, citrus, tropical fruits or processed food (sliced fruits are considered processed).

You must be 60 years old by December 31, 2017 (or older) to be eligible.

Each eligible senior may receive four - \$5.00 checks **for a total benefit of \$20.00** during the program year.

Checks will be available at the Berks County Area Agency on Aging and Berks County Senior Centers.

- Must show ID for proof of age and PA residency
- Income is self-declared

To be eligible for the Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program your income must be less than:

- 1 person in the household \$22,311
- 2 people in the household \$30,044
- 3 people in the household \$37,777
- 4 people in the household \$45,510
- 5 people in the household \$53,243
- 6 people in the household \$60,976

Please remember that all checks must be used by November 30th
