Skateboarders, BMX Bikers and In-line Skaters of all ages and abilities are welcome to test their skills, tricks and abilities on the Action Park. Pre-registration will be accepted at the **Berks County Parks & Recreation Dept.** by mailing a completed registration form to 1901 Tulpehocken Road, Wyomissing, PA 19610, Attn: Skills Competition or by calling 610-374-2944. Registration and check-in on Saturday, June 25, will begin at 11 am at the Action Park on a first-come, first-served basis. Spaces are limited.

Registration fee is \$10 per division, before Saturday, June 25. Registration will be accepted on Saturday with a \$15 entry fee per division. Participants may be in more than one division, if space allows. Spaces are limited. First competition begins at 12 noon. Divisions: Skateboard, BMX Bike, In-line Skate and "Best Trick". Categories: Beginner, Intermediate or Advanced. Judges reserve the right to make the final decision on which level is appropriate for each competitor. Prizes will be awarded in each division for 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place.

### Come to compete or just come to watch!

- Safety Gear Required! This includes a helmet.
- Shirts Required.
- Beginner riders get a 1-minute run, Intermediate riders get a 1½-minute run, and Advance riders get a 2-minute run.
- Entry Fees: **\$ 10.00 per Division, early registration** (before June 25)  
**\$ 15.00 per Division, day of competition**

# 2011 Triple B Competition

## Skills & Tricks Competition for Bikes, Blades & Boards Registration Form

**Saturday, June 25** (Rain Date: July 2) **12:00 PM**



**Competition Rules:**

1. Helmets are mandatory; all other safety equipment is **strongly recommended**.
2. Registration forms for athletes under the age of 18 require a parent's or legal guardian's signature.
3. Organized practice times will be conducted at the discretion of the event coordinator.
3. Participants are responsible for the actions of their accompanying relatives and friends.
4. The event coordinator has the authority to refuse entry to or disqualify anyone from competition.
5. We reserve the right to change format as needed to provide the safest and most organized competition.

**Judging:** There will be three judges in each division. The scores from all three judges will be averaged for the final score of each athlete. Judging will be provided by local skate/bike shops or industry-related representatives.

**Awards:** Each category will have awards for the top three athletes. All awards will be handed out at the end of each division.

**Music:**

1. Athletes must bring their own music in CD format or the event coordinator will provide music.
2. Athletes are responsible for the music selection. Music may not contain profane language or material offensive to the general public. If music must be stopped, the rider will complete his/her run without music. This situation will negatively affect their score.
3. Performance time starts at the beginning of the music. The music will be stopped at the end of the rider's prescribed time. Any trick or portion of a maneuver performed after time has expired will not be scored. The announcer will give a 30 second warning.

**Routine Interference:** If a routine is disrupted because of circumstances out of the athlete's control, such as spectator interference, sound system failure or weather, the clock will be stopped immediately. The athlete will be given the option for a full rerun or to complete the remaining time.

If a routine is interrupted due to equipment failure, the rider must signal the judges to stop timing. An on-the-spot evaluation will be made to determine if the rider can make repairs in a reasonable amount of time. If an athlete is allowed to make repairs, he/she will be allowed to complete the remaining time. If it is within the first half of a run the athlete can chose a rerun.
