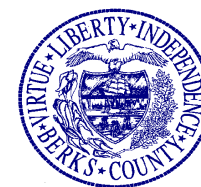

PennDOT LTAP: Helping municipalities provide a safer, more efficient transportation system in Pennsylvania

The Pennsylvania Local Technical Assistance Program (LTAP) was created to share transportation knowledge, improve road maintenance and safety skills, and put research and new technology into practice at the local level. Established by the Federal Highway Administration in 1983, Pennsylvania LTAP is part of a network of 57 LTAP centers nationwide that support city, borough, and township officials and their road crews.

LTAP in Berks County

The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) Local Technical Assistance Program (LTAP), in partnership with the Reading Area Transportation Study (RATS) and the Berks County Planning Commission (BCPC), is designed to help municipalities, which maintain over 68,000 miles of roadways, make the best use of their roadway maintenance dollars. LTAP provides free technical information and proven technologies dealing with roadway maintenance and safety methods to meet the growing demands on municipal governments.
