Governor Mifflin Safe Routes to School Transportation Improvements	Governor Mifflin School District will undertake a series of infrastructure improvements to facilitate safe transportation to Governor Mifflin Middle School and other community facilities at its Secondary Campus. The improvements will take place along S. Waverly Street, which bisects the Secondary Campus and serves as a vital pedestrian linkage for students and community members.	\$726,406.40
Ontelaunee Township Stormwater Improvements	<p>The proposed project has two locations within Ontelaunee Township. The first location is on Lakeshore Drive and addresses the pollution of Lake Ontelaunee, an impaired body of water, by stormwater runoff from roadways in the area. This problem will be remedied by the installation of a vegetated swale and rain garden to help filter out pollutants before the runoff reaches Lake Ontelaunee.</p> <p>The second location is within the Willow Creek subdivision and addresses the pollution of Willow Creek by stormwater runoff from roadways in the area. This problem will be remedied by a wet pond to help clean up discharge that would otherwise flow from roadways and paved surfaces directly into the creek.</p>	\$233,704.90
