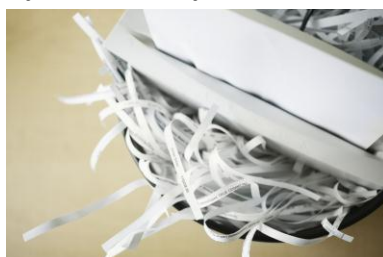
Residents of Berks County are encouraged to bring personal and confidential documents to our shredding event. No need to remove binder covers or staples.
