

## 03/11/2014 14233 Kutztown Rd MVA-Unknown

On 02-11-2014 at 1127 hrs Rescue 32, Rescue 33, Engine 45 and 535 were dispatched to 14233 Kutztown Rd for an MVA Unknown. Lieutenant 33 responded with the additional of a Tractor Trailer struck and truck and there is diesel fuel on the road. Rescue 33 and Assistant 33 responded with the same additional. In the meantime Lieutenant 33 arrived on scene, confirmed negative injuries. He had 2 Patients for evaluations only. The larger problem came to light when he confirmed approximately 100 gallons of diesel fuel on the roadway. All units coming in had the orders to stage in the surrounding parking lots and Fire Police shut down the highway between farmer's drive and Route 662. Crews were on the scene for a couple hours controlling the hazard. Special units such as a sand truck from PENDOT and a spill trailer from Company 10 were called in to assist with absorbent. All crews cleared the scene at 1404.
