

03-22-2014 Lake Rd Brush Fire

On 03-22-2014 at 1228 hrs Company 33 received the copy and respond from Berks for Tanker and Brush 33 to respond to a Brush fire on Lake Rd in Richmond Township. Brush, Tanker, Engine, and Ladder 33 responded immediately with a total of 12 personnel. Brush 33 advised Chief 33 that they had a large white smoke column showing from Virginville. Upon Arrival Chief 33 gave the working fire advisory to incoming units and added several mutual aid companies for additional apparatus and personnel. Several Forestry lines were stretched and Brush 32 was sent to the top of the hill to stop the fire from progressing into the open fields. The fire was placed under control at 1322 hrs with extensive overhaul. All fire companies cleared the scene at 1457 hrs and turned the remainder of the incident over to forestry company 82 (Hamburg Forestry). Thank you to all of the mutual aid companies for all of their hard work.
