

5-4-2014 Hamburg Boro N. 3rd St Structure Fire

On 5-4-2014 at 0123 hrs Ladder 33 was dispatched to assist company 61(Hamburg) with a possible structure fire. Deputy 61-2 was first on air to receive the additional of an oxygen tank explosion. Upon arrival on scene he gave a 3 story end of the row with heavy fire from divisions 1 and 2. Companies 61, 40 and one firefighter from 33 (who responded to the scene) stretched two lines in through the front door for an interior attack. Ladder 33 received orders while entering the Borough to go to the roof and vent. Ladder and Engine 33 crews ground laddered the A side and stretched a line to the third floor via the ground ladder. All crews made a great nock on the fire and held everything to the initial fire building. All units cleared the scene by 0555.
