

May 4th to the 11th week end report

During the week of May 4th to the 11th Station 33 responded to 7 calls. On the 4th Rescue 33 was dispatched for QRS at Christman Lake assisting 670 (Schuylkill Valley EMS) for a medical call. Station 33 had 7 Members respond. Our EMT's attended to the patient till EMS arrived.

The 6th proved to be a very busy day for the 33 house. We took in 4 calls for the day. The first was a structure response for a greenhouse fire. Engine 33 was due on the response assisting Station 40 (Shoemakersville). Station 40 apparatus and Officers arrived on location and found the fire out and no services needed. The assignment was then recalled and placed available. Station 33 had 5 members respond.

A short time later Ladder and Engine 33 were dispatched to Hamburg Borough for a Structure Fire on State St near 5th St. with reports of smoke from the 2nd floor windows. Deputy 61-2 (J. Emes) and Deputy 33 arrived on scene at the same time and the Hamburg Command was established. Upon further investigation it was found to be burnt food on the stove and the 33 apparatus were recalled in route. Station 33 had 7 members respond.

Number 3 for the day was Engine 33 being sent on the structure fire response to assist 46 (Kutztown) on Main street in the Borough. Upon the arrival of Lt. 46-1 (M. Russo), it was found to be a bush burning 5 feet from the building with no extension. The Lt. held the assignment to Station 46 and recalled the balance of the assignment. Station 33 had 7 members respond.

Later that evening Station personnel met at station for our weekly training. Several members attended the second session of our current pump class, while other members worked on equipment around the station.

After class, while finishing up tasks around the engine house Station 33 along with 61 (Hamburg) for the assist, was dispatched to Balthaser Rd. in Windsor Twp. for an unknown type fire possibly a bon fire. Chief, Brush, Tanker and Engine all went responding within minutes. Chief 33 arrived on scene and reported a 30X30 bon fire. Brush 33 was given orders to pull down an access lane next to the property and extinguish the fire. Crews from 33 and 61 worked to extinguish the fire. The Township Fire Marshall was also on scene and talked to the property owner. Station 33 had 11 Members respond.

The final call for the week came in on the 9th. Engine 33 was dispatched to Kutztown Borough to assist 46 (Kutztown) with a structure fire on Main Street reported to be smoke in the building. Deputy 46 (T. Behm) arrived on scene and established Kutztown Command with nothing showing from the exterior. Station 46 apparatus arrived on scene and the call was scaled back to the 46 unit on scene with the balance of the assignment being recalled and placed available. Station 33 had 5 members respond.
