ORDINANCE #526

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF KENHORST, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE UTILIZATION OF PORTABLE HOME STORAGE UNITS, SUCH AS PODS, MINI'S, SPUDS, ETC.

BE IT ORDAINED and **ENACTED** by the Council of the Borough of Kenhorst and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Borough of Kenhorst of the same:

SECTION I. Portable on-demand storage structures, temporary storage units, (hereinafter known as "PODS") and placed on a residential, corporate or association property shall first secure a permit from the Borough of Kenhorst Office.

SECTION II. The petitioner must first submit an application and receive a permit from the Borough. An Insurance Certificate providing Liability Insurance in the amount of \$100,000.00 provided by the company supplying the POD must accompany the application.

SECTION III. Permit Fees for the use of PODS shall be as follows: Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) per day for the first three days. Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for the period of four to seven days and One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each additional seven day period after the first seven days.


SECTION IV. PODS units shall be placed on the owner's driveway of the property. All locations must be paved off-street surfaces.

SECTION V. If PODS units must be placed on a street the property owner must obtain pre-approval of the location and erect No Parking Signs 24-48 hours prior to placement of PODS. No Parking Signs may be obtained at the Borough of Kenhorst. Each No Parking Sign cost Five Dollars (\$5.00) each. All PODS must have reflective fluorescent signs posted, and blinking lights, which shall be visible at night.


SECTION VI. Only one PODS unit may be placed at or near a property at one time.


SECTION VII. Any person who shall place a PODS unit in violation of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction before a District Justice, be sentenced to pay a fine not less than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), together with cost of prosecution, and upon default in the payment thereof be sentenced to undergo imprisonment for a period not exceeding 30 days.
