Stormwater occurs when precipitation from rain or snowmelt flows over the ground and into the municipal storm sewer system. The flow then enters our local waterbodies without being treated.



To help keep our local water bodies clear and clean, you can do your part by helping Leesport Borough identify illicit discharge or pollution entering the stormwater system. The images below depict everyday items that impact the municipal stormwater system.
