**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF LONGSWAMP, BERKS COUNTY PENNSYLVANIA,
RECOGNIZING THE NEED TO IMPROVE STATE ROUTE 222
NORTH FROM ONTELAUNEE TOWNSHIP TO INTERSTATE 78**

WHEREAS, State Route 222 North from Reading to Interstate 78 is a crucial transportation artery in Berks County; and


WHEREAS, the economies of Longswamp Township and Berks County depend on the speedy transfer of goods and ideas from across the Mid-Atlantic region. Adequate infrastructure is essential to making the region attractive to new business, retaining existing business and providing a competitive advantage over other regions; and

WHEREAS, State Route 222 is insufficient to meet the evolving needs of commerce and must be expanded and improved to ensure the successful long-term development of Longswamp Township and Berks County.


