### FINANCE

### BUILDING, ZONING, FIRE & WATER

1. Dale Eisenhofer made a motion to approve approx... \$500 for paint to paint the salt shed, seconded by Shirley Stuebner and duly passed by council.
2. Rates for rental of the band shell at the park were set at \$50 for residents and \$65 for non-residents with a motion made by Dale Eisenhofer, seconded by Jane Hoffman with all voting in favor.

### RECREATION

1. Jane Hoffman made a motion to hire 2 PT and 1 FT playground leaders for this season. Seconded by Shirley Stuebner and duly passed by council.
2. There was discussion regarding paint at the playground.

### GRANTS & ACQUISITIONS, COMMUNITY RELATIONS

1. Bailey discussed the Park and Recreation Website; Jen will be designated as the borough representative to update the website.

### LIGHT & HIGHWAY

1. Council agreed to correct the problem on the detention pond near Church Road caused by a previous attempt to repair it. It was noted that the maintenance responsibility for storm water facilities is the property owners. Solicitor Hoffert will notify property owners in writing that maintenance is their responsibility.

The Treasurers Report was approved with a motion made by Dale Eisenhofer and seconded by Shirley Stuebner and duly passed by council.
