### FINANCE

1. The 2014 Budget was adopted after a motion made by Dale Eisenhofer which was seconded by Dennis Frymoyer. A roll call vote was taken, with all members voting in favor. The budget for the General Fund is \$1,266,945 and the Fire Fund is \$85,275.

### HEALTH & SANITATION

1. The contract to dispose of refuse at the Pioneer Landfill was approved, this is a 4 year contract.
