

South Heidelberg Police Department Curfew for Minors

**Ord.
72**

Pursuant to ordinance No. 72, a year round curfew of 9:30pm is in effect for anyone 17 years of age or younger unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Parents: Make sure you know where your children are, who they are with and when they are out of the house. As summer approaches, it becomes common place for our officers to find juveniles out at all times of the night. Often, they will have snuck out of the house without anyone's knowledge, leaving through a bedroom window or basement door after parents have gone to bed.

As always, we ask for your help in keeping our community safe. As you drive to and from your home, make an effort to observe what is normal for your street. This way you will be to recognize when something appears to be outside the norm or just "not right". Be aware of your surroundings; at home, take time to lookout of your windows and doors at your street and your neighbor's homes and familiarize yourself with how the neighborhood typically looks. If you are not sure if something you observe is suspicious or does not look normal to you, do not hesitate to contact the Police Department by calling 610 655-4911 to make a report.
