



## Trash and Recycling Guidelines

Trash and recycling is mandatory in South Heidelberg Township.





## TRASH SERVICE

### TRASH SERVICE INCLUDES

Eight (8) bags of household trash no heavier than 50 lbs. per pick up day.

### BULK ITEMS

One bulk item per week (i.e., sofa, chair, washer, dryer, bundle of branches). This item should weight no more than 200 lbs.)

### YARD WASTE

Bags or barrels of yard waste (shrubs, tree trimmings, bush pruning, etc.) per pick up day.

Branches (bulk item) should be tied in bundles. Branches no longer than four feet in length, and weighing no more than 50 lbs. per bundle. Four bundles allowed per pick up day. *Leaves and grass clippings are not acceptable for recycling or inclusion in residential waste. Leaves and grass clippings can be taken to the organic waste site located on Point Road. (Map back page).*

### COLLECTION TIPS

Package glass or any other sharp objects carefully. Double or triple bagging as well as identification of contents is very helpful and can avoid injuries to customers and employees.

If you use trash bags for trash collection and experience difficulty with animals in your trash, sprinkle a small dose of ammonia in your trash bag as a deterrent.

### LEAF COLLECTION



During the fall, a separate leaf collection is provided by the Township. Residents will be notified of collection period and where to place leaves. Leaf collection is done on a rotating Township district basis, and will continue as weather permits.



### NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Ceramics
  - Drinking Glasses
  - Light Bulbs
  - Pizza Boxes (acceptable if not greasy)
  - Plastic Shopping Bags
  - Plastic—Tubs, Plates, Jars, Bags or Motor Oil Bottles.
  - Plate Glass
  - Siding
  - Styrofoam
  - Window Glass
  - Wrapping Paper
- (Greasy products not accepted)*



*Plastic shopping bags: Check your local grocery store for collections.*

### SORTING GUIDELINES:

#### Metal/Glass/Plastic

Place together into the provided recycling container. Rinse container, and remove lids—lids can be recycled.

#### Paper/Cardboard

Paper items must be placed into brown paper bags, plastic tubs or bundled. If bundled, tie with a string and bundle no larger than 2'x2'. *All paper can be combined, i.e. corrugated cardboard with office paper, magazines, cereal boxes etc. (No plastic wrapping allowed.)*

*Reduce possibility of littering - Secure lids on cans and make sure items are tied or bagged.*
