This training will consist of a half day of ICS and NIMS refresher, followed by a facilitated tabletop exercise. During the second half of the day, participants will have the opportunity to discuss plans, policies and procedures and to evaluate the systems needed to guide the prevention of, response to and recovery from a hypothetical scenario. The tabletop exercise is designed to foster discussion among response partners from the local, county and state levels. The overarching goal of the training is to foster a better understanding of the roles, responsibilities and capabilities of the partner agencies/organizations that would respond to an incident involving the water sector.
