

ORDINANCE NO. 01-2015 (PEACH STREET BRIDGE 10B)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF BERKS, PENNSYLVANIA, DELEGATING TO THE SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION THE COUNTY'S AUTHORITY TO ACQUIRE RIGHT-OF-WAY NECESSARY FOR THE PEACH STREET BRIDGE (10B) PROJECT IN KUTZTOWN BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the County of Berks and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, have coordinated through appropriate officials a county bridge replacement project for the Peach Street Bridge (10B) (the "Project") in Kutztown Borough; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 96-15, adopted April 2, 2015, the Commissioners of Berks County authorized Ryan Hunter, Director of Facilities and Operations, to execute for and on behalf of the County an agreement for the Commonwealth's performance of the Project; and

WHEREAS, Agreement No. R15050003 for the Project (the "Project Agreement") was fully effective on April 17, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of Transportation, acting for and on behalf of the Governor as well as himself, wishes to proceed in a prompt manner with the acquisition of all necessary right-of-way for the Project.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to Sections 2305 and 2307 of the General Local Government Code, 53 Pa. C.S. §§ 2305, 2307, and Paragraph 23 of the Project Agreement, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the County of Berks, as follows:

SECTION 1. Delegation of Authority.

The Commissioners of Berks County hereby delegate to the Secretary of Transportation the County's authority to acquire the right-of-way necessary for the Project described in the Project Agreement which is incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth.

SECTION 2. Duration.

This delegation shall continue until all terms and conditions of the project Agreement shall be fully satisfied or, at the election of the parties as set forth therein, the same shall be otherwise terminated.

SECTION 3. Purpose and Scope of Delegation.

The Secretary of Transportation shall have the authority to acquire the right-of-way necessary for the Project described and enumerated in the Project Agreement.

SECTION 4. Financing.

One hundred percent of right-of-way acquisition costs, along with all other costs under the Project Agreement are being funded with 80% federal funding, 15% state funding and 5% local funding.

SECTION 5. Organizational Structure.

All pre-construction phases of the Project shall be managed, directed and performed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation.

SECTION 6. Property.

The Secretary of Transportation shall acquire property pursuant to all applicable policies and procedures necessary for the Project as authorized by Section 2003(e) of the Administrative Code, 71 P.S. §513(e), for all transportation purposes, which shall include, and not be limited to, acquisitions for local roads and streets.


SECTION 7. Severability. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Berks that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.


SECTION 8. Repealer. Any ordinance, parts of ordinances, resolutions or parts of resolutions conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance’s provisions.

SECTION 9. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date provided by law.


