Berks Commissioners to Address Reopening Berks

Reading, PA— 5/12/2020 — On Saturday May 9, 2020 the Berks County Commissioners released a statement regarding a commitment to work on a plan to reopen Berks for business. In that release the Commissioners stated the following; “Over the next several days the Berks County Commissioners are going to secure input from Healthcare professionals, the Chamber Alliance and other business groups to develop a responsible and safe plan to reopen businesses in Berks County.”

Today the Berks County Commissioners announced that they will be presenting a status report on these efforts focusing on the “Business aspect of the plan” at an online Press Event.
