County of Berks announces delayed opening of facilities on Wednesday, Feb. 3

Reading, PA— 2/2/2021 — The Berks County Commissioners and President Judge Thomas G. Parisi have decided to delay the opening of all County buildings on Wednesday, February 3, due to the impact of the recent snowstorm. **County facilities will open to employees at 11 a.m. and will open to the public at noon.** The delayed opening does not apply to the County’s 24/7 operations. Employees of 24/7 operations should follow their department’s inclement weather policy.

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, County of Berks offices and services continue to be limited to individuals with appointments or essential/emergency needs only. All County employees and anyone else entering county buildings must wear a mask or they will be denied entrance.
