*County of Berks announces delayed opening of facilities on Tuesday, Feb. 9*

**Reading, PA— 2/9/2021** — The County Commissioners and President Judge Thomas G. Parisi have decided to delay the opening of all County facilities on Tuesday, February 9, due to the expected winter weather during the normal commute time. **County facilities will open to employees at 10 a.m. and will open to the public at 11 a.m.** The delayed opening does not apply to the County’s 24/7 operations. Employees of 24/7 operations should follow their department’s inclement weather policy.

The weekly virtual Commissioners’ Operations meeting scheduled for 9:30 a.m. will be conducted as planned.

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, County of Berks offices and services continue to be limited to individuals with appointments or essential/emergency needs only. All County employees and anyone else entering county buildings must wear a mask or they will be denied entrance.
