County of Berks announces building closures on Feb. 18 due to expected snowstorm

Reading, PA— 2/17/2021 — The Berks County Commissioners and President Judge Thomas G. Parisi have decided to close all County buildings on Thursday, Feb. 18, due to the snowstorm that is expected to start overnight. The closure does not apply to the County’s 24/7 operations. Employees of 24/7 operations should follow their department’s inclement weather policy.

Many county departments and staff will continue to work remotely during the building closure. The Board of Commissioners’ meeting for this week was previously cancelled due to a lack of quorum. The virtual Retirement Board meeting will continue as scheduled at 9:30 a.m. The agenda and link for the meeting can be [found here](#).

Due to the current forecast for the storm, County officials will monitor what develops throughout Thursday to determine if Friday operations will be affected and make any necessary announcements Thursday evening.
