

**DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY  
FOR THE COUNTY OF BERKS, PENNSYLVANIA**

**WHEREAS**, on March 12, 2020, the Berks County Board of Commissioners (“Board”) declared the existence of a disaster emergency in Berks County due to COVID-19 pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code (35 Pa.C.S. § 7501); and

**WHEREAS**, the Board recognizes that this emergency will continue to impact the residents of Berks County until at least December 31, 2020;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board, pursuant to the provisions of 35 Pa.C.S. § 7501, do hereby declare the continuation of a disaster emergency in Berks County due to COVID-19.

**FURTHER**, all provisions of the Board’s March 12, 2020 Declaration of Disaster Emergency for the County of Berks, Pennsylvania continue to remain in full force and effect until December 31, 2020, unless amended by vote of a majority of the Board.


This Declaration shall take effect immediately.


