The special meeting of the Laureldale Borough Council was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by President Larry Reber. The following Council members were present: Roy Harrington, Jason Glessner, Janet Hess, Bethany Pursell, Zachary Kuhn and Diane Choiniere. Also in attendance were Solicitor Osmer Deming and a Reading Eagle Reporter. Mayor Fred Feltenberger arrived at the meeting as the Executive Session began.

Motion was made by Jason Glessner seconded by Zachary Kuhn to accept the separation between the Laureldale Borough and Chief Ronald Fisher effective March 4, 2016. Carried upon a roll call vote.

Councillor Diane Choiniere gave an update on the rental inspections.

Officer Robert Atkins put in a request to go to training for Cody in Hershey, PA. Council agreed to the request. A motion will be made at the Council Meeting on March 14th.

Councillor Janet Hess gave a brief update on the AED's and Narcan. Further discussion will be needed regarding both items.

President Larry Reber noticed that many houses in the Borough do not have house numbers. This is a safety concern for Police, Fire and the Ambulance. Discussion on how to rectify this problem will be had with the Codes Department as well as the Police Department.

Being of no further business, the meeting was adjourned on motion by Roy Harrington seconded by Diane Choiniere at 6:45, and Council as well as the Mayor went in to an Executive Session to discuss Personnel Issues. Carried.
