RESOLUTION NO. 2017-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ESTABLISHING A FEE IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTY AND 00/100 DOLLARS AS THE ADMINISTRATIVE FEE FOR USE OF THE TOWNSHIP BUILDING FOR ZONING HEARINGS

WHEREAS, Section 908(1.1) of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. §10908(1.1), authorizes a governing body to prescribe reasonable fees with respect to zoning hearings including necessary administrative overhead connected with the hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township have determined that a reasonable fee for the administrative cost for utilization of the Penn Township Municipal Building for zoning hearings is One Hundred Fifty and 00/100 Dollars (\$150.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors pursuant to the authority granted it by the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code that a fee of One Hundred Fifty and 00/100 Dollars (\$150.00) shall be charged as an administrative fee for the utilization of the Penn Township Municipal Building for zoning hearings.

FURTHER RESOLVED, the administrative fee for utilization of the Township Building for zoning hearings shall be included in the fee for a zoning hearing as established, and as may be amended, by Resolution of the Penn Township Board of Supervisors.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that should the fee for a zoning hearing as established and as may be amended by a Resolution of the Board of Supervisors be insufficient to pay the fee for utilization of the building, the applicant for the zoning hearing shall be responsible for payment of said fee.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately, or as soon as legally permissible thereafter.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any provision, sentence, clause, section, or part of this Resolution shall for any reason be found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such determination shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Resolution, and it is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township that this Resolution would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision, sentence, clause, section, or part not been included herein.


FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby superseded.


