RESOLUTION #2017-13

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
FIXING THE VARIOUS TAX RATES FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2018.**

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ADOPTED, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Penn, that a tax be and the same it hereby levied on all real property within the Township of Penn subject to taxation for the fiscal year 2018, as follows:

Tax rate for general purposes, the sum of 1.0 mill on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of 10 cents (\$.10) on each hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation.

The same being summarized in tabular form as follows:

<u>Tax</u> <u>Valuation</u>	<u>Mills on Each Dollar of</u> <u>Assessed Valuation</u>	<u>Cents on Each One Hundred</u> <u>Dollars of Assessed</u>
General Purpose	1.0 Mill	10 cents

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Penn, that a uniform Street Light Assessment is hereby levied on all properties benefited by street lights in the Mount Pleasant Street Light District in the amount of Ninety-Eight and 00/100 dollars (\$98.00) annually per benefited property, pursuant to Penn Township Resolution No. 2010-8

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Penn, that a uniform Street Light Assessment is hereby levied on all properties benefited by street lights in the Penn Hills Phases I and II Street Light District in the amount of Twenty-Five and 00/100 dollars (\$25.00) annually per benefited property, pursuant to Penn Township Resolution No. 2010-8


FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any provision, sentence, clause, section, or part of this Resolution shall for any reason be found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such determination shall not effect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Resolution, and it is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township that this Resolution would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid provision, sentence, clause, section or part not been included herein.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby superseded.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall be effective immediately.
