RESOLUTION NO. 2018-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA APPOINTING JOSHUA FORRY AS AN ALTERNATE TO THE ZONING HEARING BOARD OF PENN TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, Section 903.53 P.S. §10903, the Board of Supervisors shall appoint residents of the municipality to the Zoning Hearing Board by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, per Section 903(b) of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. §10903(b), the Board of Supervisors may by Resolution appoint residents of the municipality to serve as alternate members to the Zoning Hearing Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township desires to appoint Joshua Forry as an alternate member to the Penn Township Zoning Hearing Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township Joshua Forry is a resident of Penn Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township desires to appoint Joshua Forry to a three (3) year term as an alternate member to the Penn Township Zoning Hearing Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township desires Joshua Forry's three (3) year term as an alternate member to the Penn Township Zoning Hearing Board to commence immediately and expiring at the January 2021 reorganizational meeting of the Township Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, Section 903, the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township resolves that Joshua Forry, a resident of Penn Township, shall be appointed as an alternate member to the Penn Township Zoning Hearing Board for a three (3) year term commencing immediately and expiring at the January 2021 reorganizational meeting of the Township Board of Supervisors.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of Penn Township shall provide a copy of this executed Resolution to the appointee.


FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately, or as soon as legally permissible thereafter.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any provision, sentence, clause, section, or part of this Resolution shall for any reason be found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such determination shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Resolution, and it is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township that this Resolution would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision, sentence, clause, section, or part not been included herein.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby superseded.



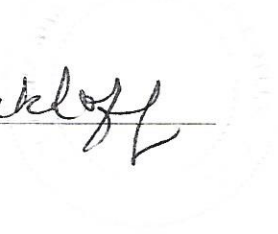
