RESOLUTION NO. 2018-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA APPOINTING SETH FISHER AS A MEMBER OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF PENN TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, Section 203, 53 P.S. §10203, the Board of Supervisors shall appoint residents of the municipality to the Planning Commission by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, there is a vacancy on the Penn Township Planning Commission for a term expiring at the January 2021 Board of Supervisors Reorganizational Meeting; and

WHEREAS, Seth Fisher is a resident of Penn Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township desires to appoint Seth Fisher to serve the remaining term for the vacant position of the Penn Township Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township desires Seth Fisher's term as a member to the Penn Township Planning Commission to commence immediately and expiring at the January 2021 reorganizational meeting of the Township Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, Seth Fisher has expressed his interest in being appointed to the Penn Township Planning Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, Section 203, 53 P.S. §10203, the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township resolves that Seth Fisher, a resident of Penn Township, shall be appointed as a member to the Penn Township Planning Commission for a term commencing immediately and expiring at the January 2021 reorganizational meeting of the Township Board of Supervisors.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of Penn Township shall provide a copy of this executed Resolution to the appointee.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately, or as soon as legally permissible thereafter.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any provision, sentence, clause, section, or part of this Resolution shall for any reason be found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such determination shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Resolution, and it is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township that this Resolution would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision, sentence, clause, section, or part not been included herein.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby superseded.


