RESOLUTION NO. 2019-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE TAX COLLECTOR OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN TO RETAIN OVERPAYMENTS OF TAXES OF FIVE AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$5.00) AND LESS AND RETURN THEM TO THE TOWNSHIP AT EACH YEAR'S END

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1506 of the Second Class Township Code, the Board of Supervisors may adopt rules and regulations for the proper management of the Township and its finances; and

WHEREAS, from time to time residents overpay their taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Collector incurs costs to return funds for overpayment of taxes, including but not limited to, postage and the costs for a check; and

WHEREAS, the costs to return funds for overpayment of taxes can exceed the amount of the overpayment; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Collector inquired if the Board of Supervisors would authorize the Tax Collector to retain overpayment of taxes of five and 00/100 dollars and less in lieu of returning the overpayment in consideration of the costs in returning the overpayment; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Collector advised that funds received as overpayment would be submitted to the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors believes it is in the best interest of the Township to authorize the Tax Collector for Penn Township to retain overpayment of taxes of five and 00/100 dollars and less in lieu of returning the overpayment in consideration of the costs in returning the overpayment and submit the amount of the tax overpayment to the Township at the end of the year; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Penn, Berks County, Pennsylvania, that the elected or appointed Tax Collector of the Township of Penn Berks County, Pennsylvania, is hereby authorized to retain overpayment of taxes of five and 00/100 dollars and less in lieu of returning the overpayment in consideration of the costs in returning the overpayment.

FURTHER RESOLVED, the Tax Collector shall submit the amount of the overpayment of the tax to the Township at the end of the year.

FURTHER RESOLVED, the Township shall utilize the funds received from the Tax Collector from overpayment of taxes toward funds the Township provides to the Tax Collector for expenses incurred in collecting Township taxes.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that that this Resolution shall take effect immediately.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any provision, sentence, clause, section, or part of this Resolution shall for any reason be found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such determination shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Resolution, and it is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township that this Resolution would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision, sentence, clause, section, or part not been included herein.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby superseded.
