RESOLUTION NO. 2020-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA APPOINTING RICH FORRY AS AN ALTERNATE TO THE ZONING HEARING BOARD OF PENN TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, Section 903, 53 P.S. §10903, the Board of Supervisors shall appoint residents of the municipality to the Zoning Hearing Board by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, per Section 903(b) of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. §10903(b), the Board of Supervisors may by Resolution appoint residents of the municipality to serve as alternate members to the Zoning Hearing Board; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the resignation of the alternate member of the Zoning Hearing Board of Penn Township a vacant position exists for an alternate on the Zoning Hearing Board; and

WHEREAS, the term of the vacant position was for a three-year term that commenced on the Board of Supervisors January 2018 Reorganizational Meeting and expires on the date of the Penn Township Board of Supervisors Reorganizational Meeting in January 2021; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 903 of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. 10903, appointments to fill vacancies on a Zoning Hearing Board shall only be for the unexpired portion of the term of the vacant position; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township desires to appoint Rich Forry to fill the vacant alternate position on the Penn Township Zoning Hearing Board for the remainder of the unexpired term; and

WHEREAS, Rich Forry is a resident of Penn Township; and

WHEREAS, Rich Forry has expressed his interest in being appointed as an alternate to fill the remainder of the term of the vacant position on the Penn Township Zoning Hearing Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to Section 903 of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. § 10903, the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township resolves that Rich Forry, resident of Penn Township, is hereby appointed to the Penn Township Zoning Hearing Board as an alternate for the remainder of the term of the vacant position commencing immediately and expiring on the date of the Penn Township Board of Supervisors Reorganizational Meeting in January 2021.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of Penn Township shall provide a copy of this executed Resolution to the appointee.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately, or as soon as legally permissible thereafter.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any provision, sentence, clause, section, or part of this Resolution shall for any reason be found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such determination shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Resolution, and it is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township that this Resolution would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision, sentence, clause, section, or part not been included herein.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby superseded.
