RESOLUTION NO. 2015-8

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF PENN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
APPOINTING RICHARD BURKEY TO THE ZONING HEARING
BOARD OF PENN TOWNSHIP**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 903 of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. 10903, the Board of Supervisors shall appoint residents of the municipality to the Zoning Hearing Board; and

WHEREAS, a vacant position exists on the Penn Township Zoning Hearing Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township desires to appoint Richard Burkey to the Penn Township Zoning Hearing Board to fill a vacant position on the Zoning Hearing Board; and

WHEREAS, the term of the vacant position was for a three-year term that commenced on January 1, 2014 and will expire on December 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 903 of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. 10903, appointments to fill vacancies on a Zoning Hearing Board shall only be for the unexpired portion of the term of the vacant position.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township as follows pursuant to Section 903 of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. 10903:

1. Richard Burkey, resident of Penn Township, shall be appointed to the Penn Township Zoning Hearing Board for the remainder of the term of the vacant position.
2. Richard Burkey's term on the Zoning Hearing Board for Penn Township shall commence immediately upon adoption of this Resolution and expire on December 31, 2016.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately, or as soon as legally permissible thereafter.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any provision, sentence, clause, section, or part of this Resolution shall for any reason be found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such determination shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Resolution, and it is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township that this Resolution would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision, sentence, clause, section, or part not been included herein.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby superseded.


