

PENN TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

ORDINANCE NO. 2010- 3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN, BERKS, COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ENACTING A NEW ORDINANCE, AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE SECOND CLASS TOWNSHIP CODE, THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION LAW AND OTHER LAWS TO ENTER INTO THE PENNSYLVANIA STORMWATER COALITION COST-SHARING AND COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH OTHER LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS IN THE PENNSYLVANIA STORMWATER COALITION FOR THE PURPOSE OF COLLECTIVELY ADDRESSING NEW FEDERAL AND STATE STORMWATER REGULATIONS AND AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT SETTING FORTH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE PENNSYLVANIA STORMWATER COALITION AND PROVIDING FOR THE TERMINATION OF SAID AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. §66507, and the Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Cooperation Law, 53 Pa.C.S. §2301, *et seq.*, the Board of Supervisors may, by ordinance, make agreements with other municipalities in performing governmental powers, duties and functions; and

WHEREAS, Penn Township and other municipalities interested in stormwater regulations desire to enter into the “Pennsylvania Stormwater Coalition Cost-Sharing and Cooperation Agreement” attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Penn Township believes that cooperation and cost-sharing to address new stormwater regulations is in the best interests of the residents of Penn Township.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Penn, Berks County, Pennsylvania (“Township”), as follows:

SECTION 1. The Board of Supervisors of the Township hereby approves entering into the “Pennsylvania Stormwater Coalition Cost-Sharing and Cooperation Agreement” (herein “Agreement”) between Penn Township and the Participating Municipalities of the Stormwater Coalition in accordance with the authorization under the Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 53 Pa.C.S. §481, *et seq.* and the Second Class Township Code, 53 Pa.C.S. §66507. A copy of the Agreement is attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein by reference.
