


**Richmond Township Board of Supervisors  
Special - Fleetwood Police Meeting  
Wednesday, September 7, 2022  
6:00 PM. at The Fleetwood Grange**

**Attendees: Scott Brinker, Brian Wanner, Chief Ulshafer, Tammy Gore, Chris Young, 15-20 residents**

1. Introductions of Chief, township supervisors and Chris Young
2. Police Power Point Presentation (attach to posted minutes?)
3. Questions/Discussions:
  - a. Where is police training held? Some basic training given in-house by chief and some off site.
  - b. Place police officer at schools? Chief has a meeting this Friday to discuss with the school district. Putting military veterans at the school was mentioned as a possibility by the public. Bringing in the Sherriff department was also mentioned, but they cannot make arrests or perform criminal investigations.
  - c. Will there be a tax increase for the township? Brian Wanner estimated a \$44/year increase based on 3,400 residents. Chris Young anticipates about the same increase for the borough.
  - d. Sheetz having their own security was brought up, due to the number of incidents/calls. Ulshafer stated that they only have security cameras that are tied to remote live security officers.
  - e. A resident brought up that they would like to see more Police presence in the township North of Route 222.
  - f. Adding additional administration staff to the Police department was discussed, wouldn't help the current staffing issues.
  - g. Ruscombmanor and Topton coverage was questioned; They each have and pay for a dedicated officer, which helps offset the overhead charges that Richmond and Fleetwood incur.
  - h. General Township communications were discussed and some suggestions were made:
    - i. Mailing newsletter – costly
    - ii. Email residents
    - iii. Facebook
  - i. It was discussed that the township is currently updating their website
  - j. A path forward and decisions will be discussed at future township supervisor's meetings and budget meetings.
  - k. Overall, residents present, were in agreement that additional police coverage is necessary.
