

The special meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Sinking Spring was called to order on Wednesday, February 10, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Sinking Spring Borough Hall by President James Pachuiilo. After the Pledge to the Flag, James Pachuiilo called the roll reflecting the following Council Members present:

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

Mr. Pachuiilo stated that they needed to go into Executive Session for a personnel issue. Council went into Executive Session at 7:05 p.m.

RECONVENE:

Council reconvened at 7:30 p.m.

COUNCIL PRESIDENT – JAMES PACHUILO:

Mr. Pachuiilo stated that they had some action to take on a personnel matter.

Mr. Huckleberry made a motion to terminate Regina Shade's employment for cause; seconded by Mr. Hoffa. Mr. Pachuiilo requested a Roll Call Vote. AYES – 6, NAYS – 1 (Mrs. Stine). Motion carried.

Mr. Huckleberry made a motion to appoint Mrs. Eageman as Secretary; seconded by Mrs. Peterson. AYES – 7, NAYS – 0. Motion carried.

Mr. Hoffa made a motion to appoint Mrs. Bohn as Treasurer; seconded by Mrs. Peterson. AYES – 7, NAYS – 0. Motion carried.

Mr. Butkus mentioned that they should check with the bonding people to make sure they are bonded. Mr. Pachuiilo stated that he believes that Mrs. Eageman and Mrs. Bohn are already bonded and that he will verify it. Mr. Haws also mentioned that he would speak to Mrs. Eageman and Mrs. Bohn about checking with the auditor to see if another audit would need to be done with the change of the Treasurer.


DENISE STINE – PUBLIC SAFETY:

Mrs. Stine mentioned that Chief Schweyer's Contract is up and that he is asking for the same thing that the Full-Time Police Officers got in their Contract which include an increase in the Longevity Pay from \$85.00 to \$90.00 for the next three years, Christmas Eve as a holiday and a 3% increase in pay each year. Mrs. Stine made the motion to renew Chief Schweyer's Contract for the next three years with the above corrections; seconded by Mr. Huckleberry. AYES – 7, NAYS – 0. Motion carried.
