Permittee hereby agrees to the following:

- a) To notify Borough within 48 hours if the work permitted shall exceed the original scope and fees on deposit for the said work. Additional fees must be deposited with the Borough to cover additional work.
- b) Provide an insurance certificate in form and amount satisfactory to the Borough for public liability and property damage.
- c) Should the costs of items 3 and 4 exceed the deposits received, the applicant shall reimburse the Borough all costs necessary and incidental thereto.
- d) In order to avoid damage to underground utility lines, Permittee shall request information as required by Pa. Act 172 of 1986 as amended, not less than three(3) working days prior to the performance of any excavation and/or demolition operations allowed under this permit, and shall comply with all other provisions of the Act.
- e) Under the subject to all the conditions, restrictions, and regulations prescribed by the Borough Street Occupancy Ordinance and under and subject to the special conditions, restrictions, and regulations hereinafter set forth or attached hereto.

- f) This permit expires one(1) year from date of Permit approval. The undersigned applicant hereby does agree to indemnify and save the Borough harmless from and against all liabilities of whatever nature arising during the performance of the work or as a result of the work for which a Permit is granted, whether or not the liability arises as a result of the negligence of the person, firm, corporation, or other entity to whom the Permit was issued.
- g) In the event of failure or neglect by the permittee to perform and comply with the permit or the regulation set forth in this Ordinance, the Borough may immediately revoke and annul the permit and order and direct the permittee to remove any or all structures, equipment or property belonging to the permittee and/or its contractors from the legal limits of the right-of-way and to restore the right-of-way to its former conditions. In the event the Borough determines that such structures, equipment or property pose a threat to the public safety and the permittee fails to remove the same after notice from the Borough to do so, any attorney of any court of record shall be authorized to appear for the permittee, and to enter an amicable action of ejectment and confess judgment against the permittee; and the prothonotary shall be authorized to issue forthwith a writ of possession with costs, without leave of court.

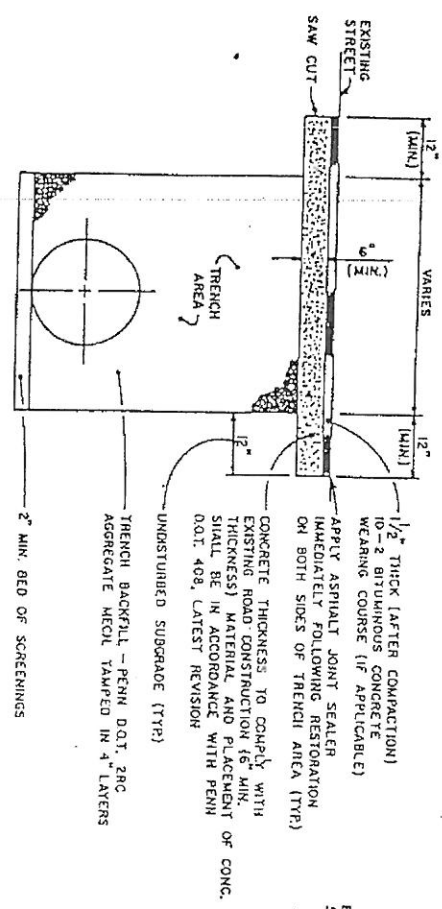

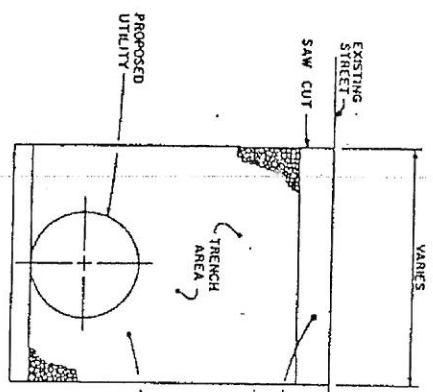

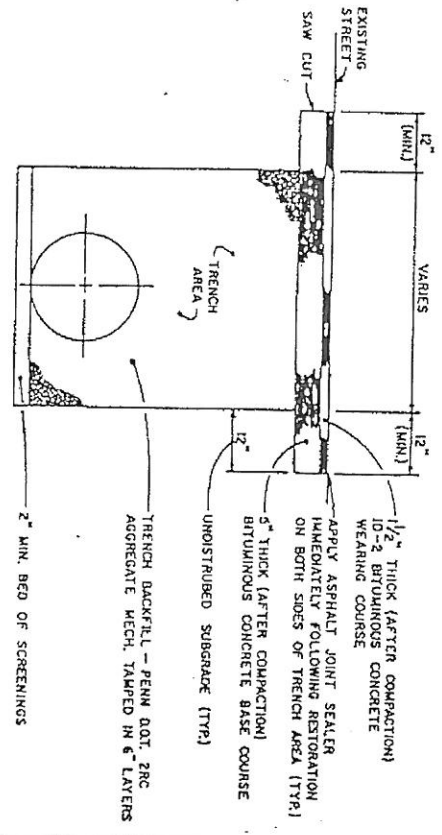
