Please note: The Borough of Sinking Spring passed an ordinance in 2004, which requires the owners of businesses or homes with FIRE ALARMS, to pay a service fee to the Borough after more than three false alarms are received in a calendar year.

Also, the Pennsylvania Crimes Code, Section 7511 (c), prohibits the permitting of more than three false alarms, FIRE OR BURGLAR, in a consecutive twelve-month period. Violators, if cited, could be required to pay a fine of up to \$300.00 plus costs.
