**ORDINANCE NO.: 2017-0076**

**AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THAT CERTAIN STOP SIGNS ON  
NAFTZINGERTOWN ROAD AND SCHOOL HOUSE ROAD BE REMOVED AND  
REPLACED WITH YIELD SIGNS, DIRECTING THAT NO PARKING SIGNS BE  
PLACED ON SCHOOL HOUSE ROAD, AND ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES FOR  
VIOLATIONS OF THE NO PARKING PROVISIONS**

***BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED***, by the Board of Supervisors of Upper Bern Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

**Section 1:** Removal. The stop sign on Naftzingertown Road (T-712) where it intersects with Winterhill Road (T-675) and the stop sign on School House Road (T-566) where it intersects with Winterhill Road (T-675) shall hereby be removed.

**Section 2:** Yield Signs. Yield signs shall be installed on Naftzingertown Road (T-712) where it intersects with Winterhill Road (T-675) and on School House Road (T-566) where it intersects with Winterhill Road (T-675).

**Section 3:** No Parking Signs. No parking signs shall be installed on School House Road (T-566) on the South bound lane along the old Upper Bern Elementary School property.

**Section 4:** Enforcement & Penalties. The Upper Bern Township Roadmaster shall have the power and duty to enforce the parking provisions of this Ordinance, and is hereby granted the authority to issue summary citations for violations. The Roadmaster is further empowered to assume charge of a prosecution before a District Magistrate to enforce a summary citation, without the consent of the District Attorney as required under Pa. R. Crim. P. No. 83(c) (relating to trial and summary cases). The Board of Supervisors hereby sets a criminal fine in the amount up to One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars per parking violation, provided, further, that each day's continuance of a violation shall constitute a separate event. The Roadmaster may direct the removal of said violation vehicle by means of vehicle tow to the nearest tow facility. The cost of such removal shall be added to the costs of the criminal complaint from the time of such removal.

**Section 5:** Repealer. All Ordinances or Resolutions, or parts of Ordinances or Resolutions, insofar as they are inconsistent herewith, shall be in the same or hereby repealed.



**Section 6:** Validity. If any Section or part of a Section of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining parts or Sections of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been enacted as if such invalid Section or portion thereof had not been included therein.

Section 7: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
