

ORDINANCE NO. 21

AN ORDINANCE OF UPPER BERN TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A TAX UPON THE TRANSFER OF REAL ESTATE, OR ANY INTEREST IN REAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL LIMITS OF UPPER BERN TOWNSHIP.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of Upper Bern Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Township does hereby establish for general revenue purposes a tax upon the transfer of real property, or any interest in real estate within the territorial limits of Upper Bern Township in accordance with the taxing powers vested in Upper Bern Township through the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as set forth in the Tax Reform Code of 1971, as amended, and more particularly set forth in Section 8101-D of Article XI-D of said Act, 72 P.S. Section 8101-D.

SECTION 2. That the imposition of this tax shall commence on the first day of July, 1989.

SECTION 3. That the Township Secretary shall send certified copies of this Ordinance to the Recorder of Deeds of Berks County, Pennsylvania, and to the Superintendent of the Hamburg Area School District.

SECTION 4. That any of other ordinance which is inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance is repealed to the extent of the inconsistency
