

ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER BERN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A 15 MILE PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT FOR THE SCHOOL ZONE RELATING TO THE UPPER BERN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ALONG OLD ROUTE 22 DURING CERTAIN HOURS OF THE DAY.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of the Township of Upper Bern, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. That a special speed limit zone for the Upper Bern Elementary School along Old Route 22 in Upper Bern Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, is hereby established at 15 miles per hour from 8:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 3:25 p.m. until 3:55 p.m., Monday through Friday.

SECTION 2. The area on Old Route 22 for the School Zone shall run from utility wooden pole no. 45928-43374 in a westwardly direction to pole no. 45865-43376. Said School Zone is more fully described in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Department of Engineering Drawing dated September 18, 1990, a copy of which is attached hereto, made a part hereof, and marked Exhibit "A".

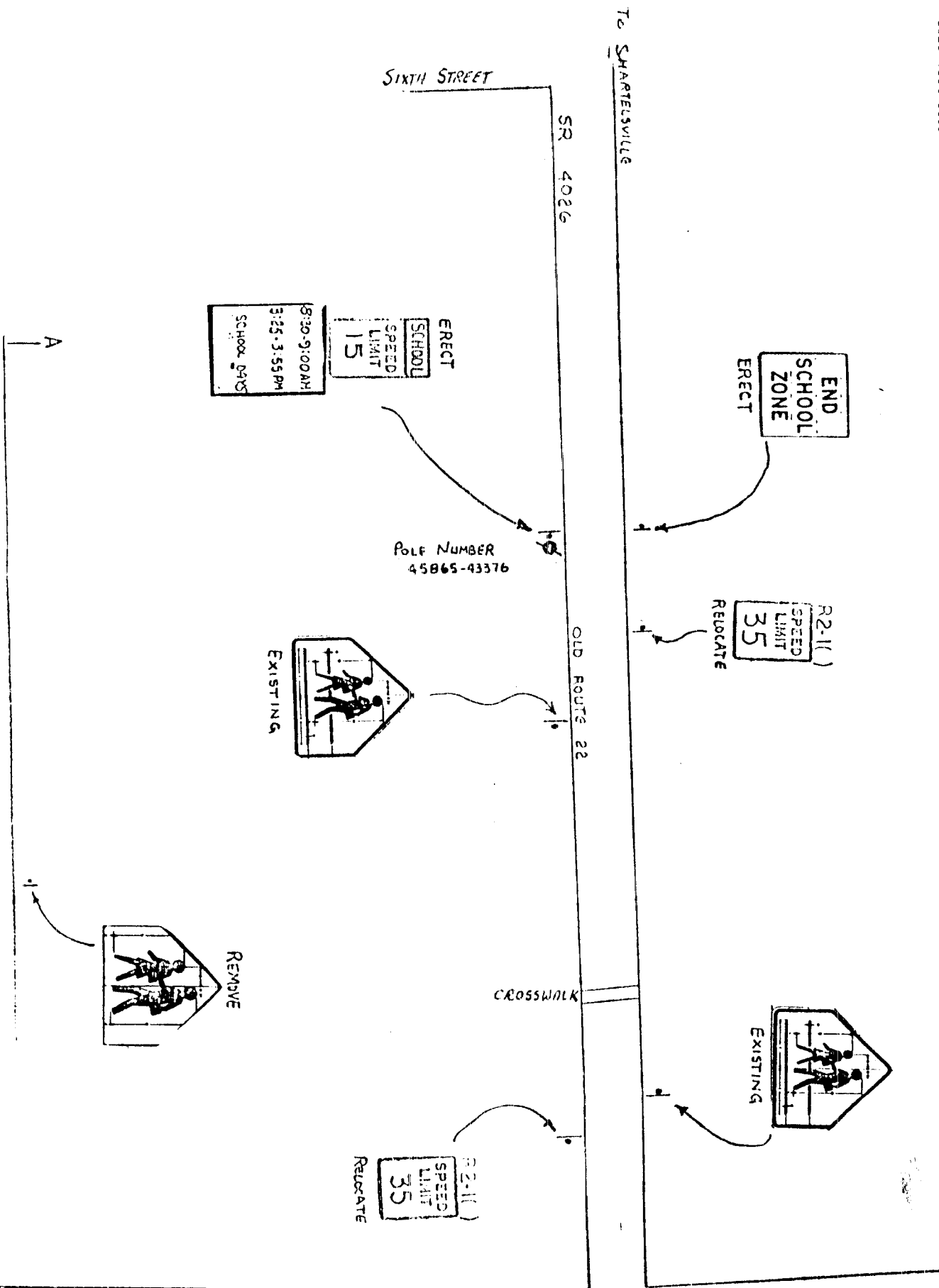
SECTION 3. Any person operating a motor vehicle violating the speed limit in the School Zone as herein set forth shall upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$35.00. Any person exceeding the maximum speed limit by more than five (5) miles per hour shall pay an additional fine of \$2.00 per mile for each mile in excess of five (5) miles per hour over the maximum speed limit.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.
