

ORDINANCE 35

AN ORDINANCE FOR UPPER BERN TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A STOP INTERSECTION ON APPLE DRIVE WHERE IT INTERSECTS WITH FIFTH STREET FOR TRAFFIC TRAVELING IN BOTH AN EASTERLY AND WESTERLY DIRECTION.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of Upper Bern Township, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. That a stop intersection is created for traffic proceeding in both an easterly and westerly direction on Apple Drive where it intersects with Fifth Street in the Village of Shartlesville, Upper Bern Township;

Section 2. That the Supervisors of Upper Bern Township are directed to erect stop signs at said intersection in accordance with regulations established by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania;

Section 3. That any person who fails to obey the stop signs controlling Apple Drive shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a summary offense and subject to a fine not to exceed \$300.00 and/or imprisonment not to exceed 30 days in the Berks County jail. In the event that the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has different fines and penalties established for such a violation, then and in that event the terms of this Section shall be superseded and controlled by the fines and penalties established by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Section 4. That any provision of any ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be repealed to the extend of the inconsistency.
