

ORDINANCE NO. 40

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER BERN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, CREATING NO PARKING ON CERTAIN SECTIONS OF NORTH FIFTH STREET AND ON MAIN STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF SHARTLESVILLE, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

BE IN ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Upper Bern, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. That parking shall be prohibited on the west side of North Fifth Street between Apple Drive and Main Street.

Section 2. That parking will be prohibited on the east side of North Fifth Street from the corner of Main Street for a distance of forty-five (45) feet toward Apple Drive.

Section 3. That parking will be prohibited on the northeast corner of Main Street where it intersects with North Fifth Street for a distance of twenty-five (25) feet east of the intersection.

Section 4. That any person violating any of the parking restrictions as herein established shall, upon conviction, be required to pay a fine of \$10.00, together with any costs associated with the prosecution thereof.

Section 5. That any provision of any ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.
