

ORDINANCE NO. 4, 1968.

AN ORDINANCE OF TOWNSHIP OF UPPER BERN,
BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING
FEE FOR ENFORCEMENT OFFICER UNDER THE
PENNSYLVANIA SEWAGE FACILITIES ACT.

BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors
of the Township of Upper Bern and it is hereby ENACTED and
ORDAINED by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. That no person shall install an individual
or community sewage disposal system, or construct any building in
the Township of Upper Bern, in which an individual or community
sewage disposal system is to be installed, without first obtaining
a permit indicating that the site, plans and specifications of
such system are in compliance with the "Pennsylvania Sewage
Facilities Act" of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, and any Rules and
Regulations adopted pursuant to the Act.

SECTION 2. A fee in the sum of Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars
shall be paid to the Township Enforcement Officer at the time of
making application for a permit under the said "Pennsylvania Sewage
Facilities Act".

SECTION 3. That any ordinance or part of any ordinance
inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same
is hereby repealed to the extent that the same is inconsistent
herewith.
