## ORDINANCE NO. 5 , 1968

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE OPENING OF CERTAIN ALLEYS ALL LOCATED IN THE VILLAGE OF SHARTLESVILLE, UPPER BERN TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Upper Bern, and IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. That the several alleys located in the Village of Shartlesville, Berks County, Pennsylvania, described as follows:

ALL THAT CERTAIN Public Thoroughfare in the Village of Shartlesville, Berks County, Pennsylvania, being known as an open alley bearing generally East and West parallel to Main Street and 200 feet north of Main Street beginning at the east side of the Public road, formerly Legislative Route #06017, thence South Eighty degrees Five minutes East a distance of Two Hundred Sixty feet, at a width of Twenty feet, and thence by the same course for a distance of Sixteen Hundred and One feet, (1601 feet) to a point in line of land of Herbert C. Moll and Mamie M. Moll, said point being 101.0 feet east of the East side of North Fifth Street, according to the Plan of Shartlesville approved and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Upper Bern Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, dated April 2, 1968, said 1601.0 feet of roadway being Thirty feet (30 feet) wide.

ALL THAT CERTAIN Public Thoroughfare in the Village of Shartlesville, Berks County, Pennsylvania, being known as an open Alleybearing generally West East and parallel to Main Street of said town, beginning at a point in line of the west side of South First Street as shown on the general plan of Shartlesville, approved and adopted by the Supervisors of Upper Bern Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, dated April 2, 1968, thence South Eighty degrees Five minutes East a distance of Three Hundred Ninety feet (390 feet) to a point in the Right of Way line of the west side of Legislative Route #06017, said Alley being Twenty Five feet (25 feet) wide.

ALSO ALL THAT CERTAIN Public Thoroughfare in the Village of Shartlesville, known as an open Alley, beginning at a point at the East side of Legislative Route #06017 and thence South Eighty degrees Five minutes East a distance of Four Hundred Eighty feet (480.0 ft.), to a point at the East side of South Third Street by said roadway being Twenty feet wide (20 ft.) as shown on the General Plan of Shartlesville.

ALSO ALL THAT CERTAIN Public Thoroughfare in the Village of Shartlesville, Berks County, Pennsylvania, being known as an open alley, bearing generally West East, beginning at a point at the East side of South Fourt Street, thence extending South Eighty degrees Five minutes East a distance of Seven Hundred Fifty Seven feet (757.00 ft.) to a point on the west side of South Sixth Street, said roadway being Twenty feet wide (20 ft.) as shown on said plan of Shartlesville,

be and hereby are opened for the free use of the general public as a public thoroughfare.

SECTION 2. That the Township Engineer be and is hereby authorized and instructed to open the said alleys as hereinbefore set forth and to remove all obstructions within the lines of said alleys, as set forth in a plan dated hay , 1965, prepared by Eliot K. Ziegler, Registered Surveyor, which plan is adopted as part hereof by reference thereto.

SECTION 3. That the Township Solicitor be and hereby is directed to take such other and further steps in Court or elsewhere as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. That any Ordinance or partsof Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed.
