

ORDINANCE NO. 6 1968

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE OPENING OF SOUTH FOURTH STREET AND SOUTH SIXTH STREET, LOCATED IN THE VILLAGE OF SHARTLESVILLE, UPPER BERN TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Upper Bern, and IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. That South Fourth Street, described as follows:

ALL THAT CERTAIN portion of land being thirty three three feet wide and being Five Hundred Ninety Five and Sixty Five Hundredths feet (595.65 feet) long, located between the north right of way line of an alley, and the south end of South Fourth Street, in the Village of Shartlesville, Upper Bern Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and the East right of way line of Legislative Route #06017, the entire proposed roadway being over lands of John J. Seitzinger and Helen M. Seitzinger, his wife, and Lillian M. Clemens and Gurney W. Clemens, her husband, more particularly bounded and described as follows,

The Centerline Courses and distances, Beginning at a point in the middle of existing South Fourth Street also in line of the north side of the Public Alley at right angles thereto, thence South Nine degrees Fifty minutes West ($S.9^{\circ} 50' W$), One Hundred Forty Four and Three tenth feet (144.30 feet) to the point of curve to the right having a radius of One Hundred Twenty Eight and Five tenth feet (128.50 feet), a distance along the Arc of the curve of One Hundred Twenty Seven and Nine tenth feet (127.90 feet) to the end of curve, thence South Sixty Six degrees Fifty Two minutes West ($S 66^{\circ} 52' W$), Three Hundred Twenty Three and Fifty Four Hundredths feet (323.54 feet) to a point at the right of way line of Legislative Route # 06017, the Public road from Shartlesville toward Bernville, the above described roadway being 0.112 Mile in length,

be and hereby is opened for the free use of the general public as a public thoroughfare.

SECTION 2. That South Sixth Street, described as follows:

ALL THAT CERTAIN portion of South Sixth Street in the Village of Shartlesville, Upper Bern Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania;

BEGINNING at a point in the South right of way line of the Public Township road T-721 opposite the northeast corner of property of William J. Stetzler and Mary A. Stetzler, his wife, and extending southwardly at right angles to T-721, a distance of 230.0 feet to a point in line with the South side of the 20 foot wide Public Alley at right angles thereto, being a width of Fifty (50) feet between right of way lines, as shown on the revised Plan of Shartlesville, dated March 1968,

be and hereby is opened for the free use of the general public as a public thoroughfare.

SECTION 3. That the Township Engineer be and is hereby authorized and instructed to open the said streets as hereinbefore set forth and to remove all obstructions within the lines of said streets, as set forth in a plan dated March, 1968, prepared by Eliot K. Ziegler, Registered Surveyor, which plan is adopted as part hereof by reference thereto.

SECTION 4. That the Township Solicitor be and hereby is directed to take such other and further steps in Court or elsewhere as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. That any Ordinance or part of Ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed.
