

ORDINANCE NO. 8 - 1969

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER BERN,
BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDI-
NANCE NO. 3 of 1967, ADOPTED MARCH 7, 1967,
WHICH IMPOSED A ONE PERCENT (1%) EARNED
INCOME TAX, BY DELETING THEREFROM A LEVY
OF A TAX UPON NON-RESIDENTS.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors
of the Township of Upper Bern, and it is hereby ENACTED AND
ORDAINED by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. That all references in the caption of the
Ordinance, Section 1, Section 2 (B) and 2 (D) and any other
portion of the said Ordinance adopted on March 7, 1967 referring
to levying an earned income tax upon non-residents for the year
starting January 1, 1970, is hereby deleted, revoked and rendered
null and void.

SECTION 2. That the remainder of the Earned Income Tax
Ordinance No. 3, adopted March 7, 1967, shall remain in full
force and effect as the same pertains to residents of the Town-
ship of Upper Bern, in all respects as set forth in the said
Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect January 1,
1970.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in-
consistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar, but
only insofar, as they are inconsistent herewith.
