

ORDINANCE NO. 76 - 1975

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER BERN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR THE OPENING OF A PORTION OF NORTH FOURTH STREET, LOCATED IN THE VILLAGE OF SHARTLESVILLE, FOR PUBLIC USE AND TRAVEL.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Upper Bern, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED and ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1 - That a portion of North Fourth Street, described as follows:

ALL THAT CERTAIN strip of land situate in Upper Bern Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and in the Village of Shartlesville, being Fifty Feet wide (50 Ft.) and extending of equal width a distance of Four Hundred Feet (400 Ft.) northwardly in an extended line of North Fourth Street of said Village of Shartlesville, also known as Township Road (T-722); said roadway passing through and/or along the several properties of Shartlesville Grange #1512 and Shartlesville Community Park Association respectively to lands of Grace Lesher and Lowell Kauffman, according to a survey plan of said proposed Road Extension, as adopted by Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Upper Bern,

be and the same is hereby opened for the free use of the general public as a public thoroughfare.

SECTION 2 - That the Township Engineer be and is hereby authorized and directed to change the Topographical Survey of the Township of Upper Bern to conform to the provisions of this Ordinance and to open part of said Street as aforesaid.

SECTION 3 - That the Township Solicitor be and is hereby directed to take such other and further steps in Court or else-

where as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4 - That any ordinance or part of ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed to the extent that the same is inconsistent herewith.
