

ORDINANCE NO. 2 /

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER BERN
BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING NO
PARKING AREAS IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS, RESTRICT-
ING PARKING IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS, AND PENALTIES
FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of the Township of Upper Bern, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED and ORDAINED by the authority of the same, as follows:

Ordinance No. 17 - 1978, Section 3 - Penalties, which reads as follows:

Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction pay a fine of Two Dollars (\$2.00) and costs of prosecution. An additional penalty of Two Dollars (\$2.00) per day will be added to said fine for every day that said fine and costs remain unpaid past the thirtieth (30th) day after conviction.

shall be amended, and as so amended, shall read as follows:

SECTION 3 - Penalties. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall have ten (10) days from the date of the violation to pay a fine of Five Dollars (\$5.00) to the Township Secretary, payable to Upper Bern Township. If payment is made within said ten (10) day period of time, no further action will be taken by the Township as a result of said violation. In the event that said payment is not made within ten (10) days, the Township Secretary shall thereafter direct the Chief of Police to prosecute the violation before the appropriate District Justice.

All other provisions of Ordinance No. 17, 1978, as hereby amended shall remain in full force and effect.
