

ORDINANCE NO. 34

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER BERN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, RESTRICTING PARKING DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF THE SHARTLESVILLE FIRE COMPANY TO THOSE PERSONS VOLUNTEERING SERVICES FOR THE FIRE COMPANY, AND ESTABLISHING ONE HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE IN FRONT OF THE FIRE COMPANY.

BE IN ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Upper Bern, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. That parking in front of the Shartlesville Fire Company on Main Street, Shartlesville, Berks County, Pennsylvania, shall be prohibited at all times by all motor vehicles except for members of the Shartlesville Fire Company who are actually performing services for the Fire Company at the time that the vehicle is parked.

Section 2. That the limitations as set forth above in Section 1 shall not apply, however, to one parking space in front of the Shartlesville Fire Company which shall be designated as a handicapped parking space. In such designated space, any person designated as a handicapped driver in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania shall be entitled to park in such space at any and all times.

Section 3. That any person violating the terms of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a summary offense and subject up to the maximum fines and penalties for summary offenses in accordance with Pennsylvania law.

Section 4. That any provision of any ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.
