

ORDINANCE NO. 45

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER BERN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A STOP INTERSECTION AT SCHWANS PRIVATE ROAD ONTO FEICK INDUSTRIAL DRIVE AND TO FURTHER ESTABLISH NO PARKING ALONG FEICK INDUSTRIAL DRIVE AND ESTABLISHING A 25 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT ON FEICK INDUSTRIAL DRIVE.

BE IN ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Upper Bern, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. That a stop intersection is hereby established for all traffic on the private road known as Schwans Private Drive entering onto Feick Industrial Drive;

Section 2. That the speed limit for Feick Industrial Drive shall be and is hereby established at twenty-five (25) miles per hour;

Section 3. That parking shall be prohibited on Feick Industrial Drive at all locations at all hours;

Section 4. That any person who shall fail to obey the stop sign as herein set forth in Section 1 shall be subject to such fines and penalties for such violation in accordance with the maximum fines established by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in effect at the time of the violation. In the event that no such fine has been established by the Commonwealth for such a violation, the maximum fine shall be Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) for each such offense;

Section 5. That any operator of a motor vehicle who exceeds the 25 m.p.h. speed limit as herein set forth in Section 2 shall be subject to such fines and penalties for such violation

in accordance with the maximum fines established by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania at the time of the violation. In the event that no such fine has been established by the Commonwealth for such a violation, the maximum fine shall be Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) for each such offense;

Section 6. That any person who shall fail to obey the no parking restriction as herein set forth in Section 3 shall be subject to a fine of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00);

Section 7. That any provision of any ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.
